Grocers Support Fresh Choices

- **♦** Expand access to nutrition prescriptions and incentives for fruits, vegetables, and dairy.
 - Increase the percentage of funding going to nutritious purchases.
 - o Allow only one organization or institution to run the program in each state.
- Prohibit the advertising of unhealthy foods as "EBT Eligible."
- **★** Ensure SNAP participants have the flexibility to meet their nutritional needs.
- Expand Healthy Benefit Cards in Medicare and Medicaid.
- **→** Ensure SNAP benefits are efficient and sufficient to purchase healthy foods and support the over 200,000 local jobs SNAP is responsible for creating and sustaining.
 - Reduce waste, fraud, and abuse by modernizing EBT cards and eliminating bad actors.
- **♦** Increase stocking requirements for SNAP authorized retailers.
 - Work with grocers to address food deserts in rural communities.
- → Bring SNAP-Ed into SNAP retail settings.
