On behalf of the nation's independent retail supermarkets and wholesalers, **the National Grocers Association (NGA) urges you to VOTE YES for H.R. 772, The Common Sense Nutrition Disclosure Act.** H.R. 772 is bipartisan legislation that would provide regulatory relief to supermarkets that are covered under the FDA Chain Restaurant Menu Labeling regulation.

The legislation includes the following reforms:

- Defines menu board as the primary listing for the customer as opposed to a caloric label for each location on which the item is listed
- Protects covered entities from frivolous private lawsuits
- Establishes a good faith threshold to ensure businesses aren't penalized for inadvertent human error
- Flexibility to establishments that carry unique items at only one location

The legislation does not exempt any businesses that are currently required to comply with the regulation, nor does it change any of the information that must be disclosed to customers. H.R. 772 simply provides additional flexibility for businesses to implement the rule in a way that fits their unique location.
